Job Description: Relief Overnight Residential Counselor

Program/ Department: Transitional Housing Program Plus (THP Plus)

Salary/Wage: \$13.00 hour

Status: Relief work. Overnight shifts from 10pm to 6am. As needed: approximately 2-5 shifts per month

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Provide checks on young adults at their apartments in South San Francisco. Checks include apartment inspections, checking if youth are at home at required curfew times, following program rules, and visitor policy of the THP Plus Program. Staff member will be onsite at the triplex completing checks throughout the night and ensuring safety of residents.
2. Report any violations of the THP Plus Program policy to Program Manager.
3. Complete appropriate documentation for unit checks.
4. Reinforce independent living skills and provide support regarding youth's transition into independent living, individual goals, and future planning.
5. Manage crises or emergency situations as they arise.
6. Provide support to program manager as needed

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Experience working with young people
- Must have reliable vehicle, valid drivers license, proof of insurance
- Be able to pass fingerprint clearance
- Strong communication skills, sound judgment, ability to set good boundaries

PREFERED QUALIFICATIONS:

- BA/BS degree in psychology, social work, sociology (or other related field) and/or extensive experience working with adolescents.
- Experience working with foster care youth

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION: THP Plus is a residential program for youth ages 18-24 who have exited the foster care and/or probation system. The goal of the program is to appropriately prepare these young adults for self-sufficiency upon leaving the program. The program provides case management, advocacy/support, and independent living skills education to residents.
